SUBMISSION CRITERIA

Each submission must include a **cover page** and **2-3 page summary**.

The **cover page** should include:

- Title
- Poster category (research or innovative practice)
- Name(s) of presenters and their affiliations (e.g. name of university or district)
- E-mail and phone number of primary presenter

For **research studies**, the summary must contain:

- An overview
- Description of methods
- Results
- Implications of the study

For **innovative practices**, the summary must contain:

- An overview of the practice
- Purpose
- Description of implementation
- The significance of the practice to the field of school psychology and its benefits or potential benefits to a school or school system

Your submission will be reviewed by our peer-review committee, and you will receive notification of your acceptance by Monday, October 2.
