

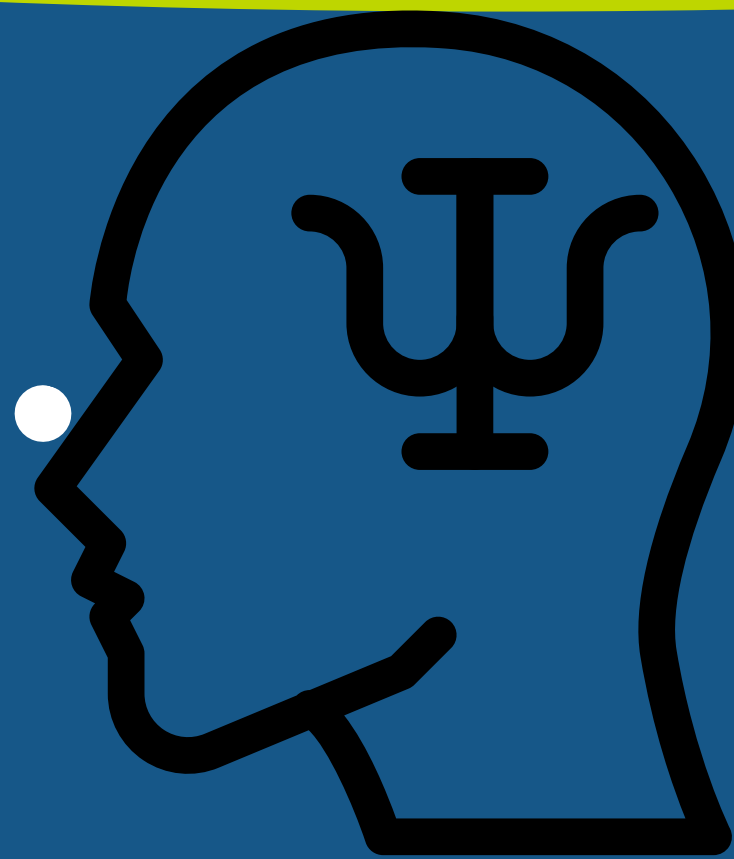

# The WCPSS School Psychology Department

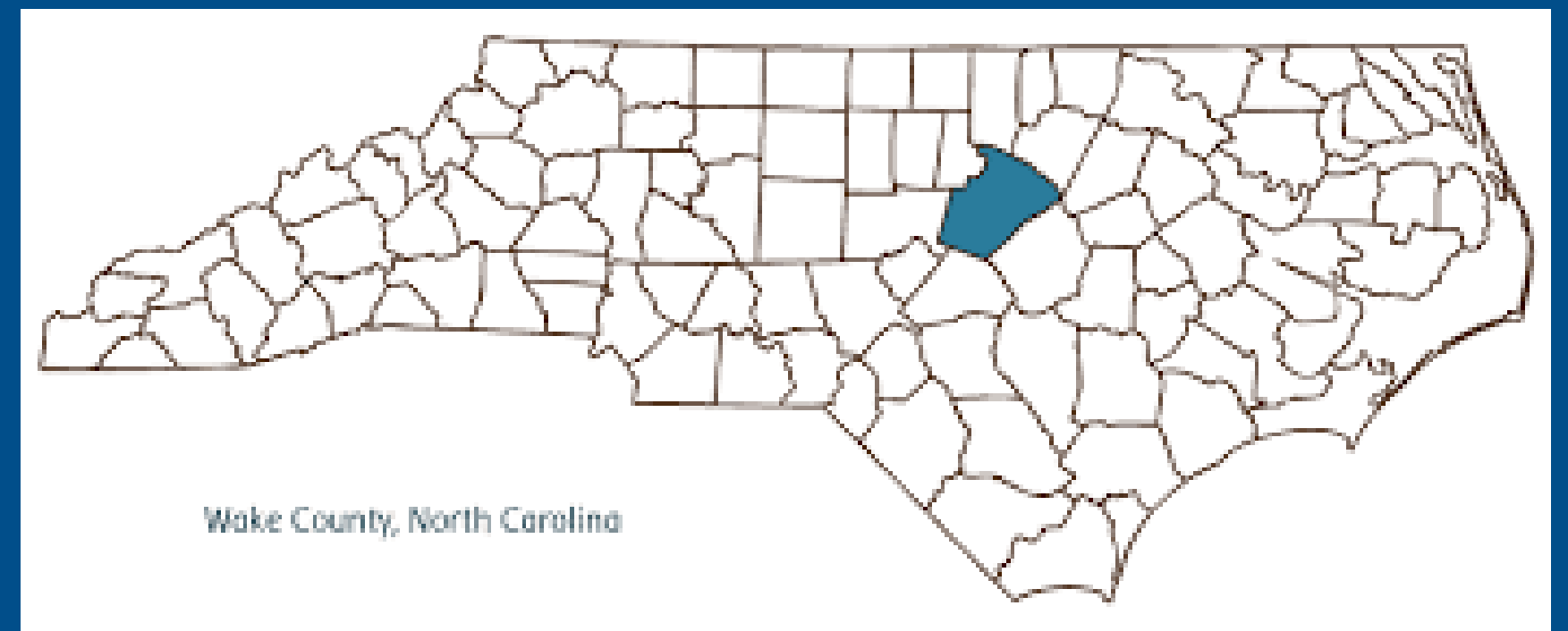
The Wake County Public School System (WCPSS) is made up of 126 school psychologists who support 198 schools and 11 preschool evaluation teams.

# As a WCPSS School Psychology Intern

Your experience would be enhanced and supported through a number of networking opportunities:

# Interested in Applying? Here's what to do:

- Complete [this information form](#) if you are interested in applying.
- Email the following as attachments to Alma Harness (aharness@wcpss.net), School Psychology Lead for internship programming:
  - A cover letter indicating why you are interested in seeking an internship with WCPSS
  - Your CV/Resume
  - At least one letter of reference (no more than 2)
  - Graduate and undergraduate transcript (unofficial or student copy is acceptable for application purposes)
  - An electronic portfolio of artifacts highlighting various aspects of your School Psychology training thus far (e.g. Presentations or Trainings, Projects, Classroom Lessons and/or Psychological Reports completed during your practicum/externship)
- Once all your documents are received, they will be reviewed.
- If you are selected for an interview you will be contacted via email by the end of the day on Tuesday, December 19, 2023 to schedule an interview for January or February 2024.
- Invitations for internship placement are made after all scheduled interviews have concluded.
  - Please note: if you are selected to become a WCPSS intern you may need to purchase professional liability insurance in addition to the Certificate of Insurance provided by your university
- All documents must be submitted and received by 5 pm on FRIDAY, DECEMBER 15, 2023
