Nash County Public Schools is currently seeking applicants for a school psychologist or school psychology internship position. This position is available for an immediate hire, or to begin with the 2022-23 school year.

School psychologists in Nash County Public Schools enjoy a comprehensive role within their assigned schools, as well as at the district level. Psychologists are school-based and have a ratio of about 1:1400, which is significantly better than the NC average of 1:2100. They help lead MTSS implementation within their schools and provide counseling support as needed. School psychologists also participate in district-level teams, including Autism Support, Assistive Technology, and District MTSS Academic and Behavioral Support teams. School psychologists also contribute to mental health support planning and help lead training in Threat Assessment, Crisis Prevention and Intervention, and Resiliency.

Nash County is located just east of the Triangle and is an easy commute, going against traffic, from Wake County. Nash County also offers low housing costs for those looking to relocate. The NC beaches, including the Outer Banks and Atlantic Beach, are an easy 2.5 hour drive.
